Code of Conduct

All attendees, speakers, sponsors and volunteers at our summit following the event code of conduct. Organizers will enforce this code throughout the event. We expect cooperation from all participants to help ensure a safe environment for all.

The Women in Cloud summit is dedicated to providing a harassment-free summit experience for everyone, regardless of gender, gender identity and expression, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, race, ethnicity, religion, or technology choices. We do not tolerate harassment of summit participants in any form. Sexual language and imagery is not appropriate for any summit venue, including talks, workshops, parties, and online media. Summit participants violating these rules may be barred from participating at the Summit at the discretion of the organizers.

Harassment includes offensive verbal comments related to gender, gender identity and expression, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, ethnicity, religion, technology choices, inappropriate images in public spaces, deliberate intimidation, stalking, following, harassing photography or recording, inappropriate physical contact, and unwelcome attention.

Participants asked to stop any harassing behavior are expected to comply immediately and may also be asked to leave the remainder of the Summit at the discretion of the organizers.

If you are being harassed, notice that someone else is being harassed, or have any other concerns, please contact a member of the summit staff identified wearing staff or volunteer badges.

We expect all participants to follow these rules at the summit and summit-related social events.
